Dear Statesmen Marching Band, new and returning Wind Symphony and Concert Band members, and other prospective Truman Bands students:

We have several new faculty joining us this year including Dr. Aren Van Houzen as our new trumpet professor and Dr. Jill Phillips, our new applied voice faculty, both of whom will be joining Wind Symphony I in performance on November 18 for the Honor Band concert!

We have an amazing staff and leadership team lined up for the 2024 Statesmen season. The theme of the show this season is Rock and Roll World Tour! The Showgirls will join us again to perform at the games. All incoming Statesmen will complete a "Statesmen Check-in" on Wednesday, August 14 after getting settled on campus. After you audition during the first week of school, whatever ensemble you are assigned to will be the one to which you should change your enrollment. There is no penalty for changing the section you are enrolled in during the first week of school.

Section leaders and drum majors will be able to move in early and will take part in our leadership retreat on Tuesday, August 13. This is an exciting opportunity for Statesmen leaders to come together to hone their leadership skills and to help shape the season ahead. There are several important things for new members to note. School instruments and lockers will be issued at that time (other times available during Truman week as well). The first activity for freshmen to attend after Check-in is on Thursday, August 15 at 6:15pm in Ophelia Parrish. This is a general music interest meeting that will include information about auditions, instruments, lockers, and other updates. If you have any questions about auditioning for Wind Symphony please email me. I will be available during for office hours or email me to arrange a time.

Statesmen General Information

For all Statesmen Marching Band members:

All members will need to provide the following items: all-white marching shoes, white athletic shoes/socks and a pair of khaki shorts and pants. Shoes are available to order from the band office (OP1318) they will be approximately \$30.

Band dues are \$44 (paid as course fee through university account) and include a pair of gloves, a Statesmen Marching Band t-shirt and the Banquet.

Also, all pregame music will be posted at http://bands.truman.edu/athletic-bands/marching-band/ Please work on this music before arriving on campus. Self-select the most appropriate part for you and adjustments will be made if needed.

For all Freshmen:

The Truman Week activities include a meeting on Thursday, August 15 at 6:15 P.M. in OPPH. Information concerning auditions, lockers, instrument checkout and calendar updates will be given out. We will ask you to fill out forms, so be sure to bring your university email address with you.

Please bring your driver's license and social security card in order to complete necessary tax forms to receive your cash stipend at the end of the marching season during the Check-in (see below).

Statesmen CHECK-IN

After you move-in to campus on Wednesday, August 14 come to the Band Office in OP1318 (Ophelia Parrish) and complete your Statesmen Check-in. At this time, you'll complete your instrument rental and receive a locker (if needed), finish ordering shoes (if needed), complete your stipend paperwork (**bring your driver's license and Social Security Card**). We will distribute uniforms at a later time. Statesmen leadership will help you all along the way and will be available from 8:00-5:00. **Otherwise check-in between 12 and 2 on Sunday, August 18.**

For all Statesmen Color Guard members:

The costs are: band dues (\$44), shoes, gloves, and possibly other costuming. We try to keep these costs under \$75.00 total. If you are interested in spinning weapon, please bring your own rifle/sabre.

For all Statesmen Drumline members:

The costs are: band dues (\$44), shoes (\$30) and appropriate sticks (\$20-\$30) Besides normal Monday, Wednesday, Friday rehearsals there will be additional late Wednesday (or TBD) rehearsals.

Wind Symphony Auditions

Auditions for Wind Symphony (1 and 2) will take place August 18, 19 and 20. Ensemble placement will be determined through a **blind audition**. This means that your placement will be determined based solely on your playing during the audition without the panel knowing the identity of the person auditioning. Everyone auditioning for Wind Symphony will play: 1. Scales, 2. Excerpts, and 3. Sight-reading in that order. Either a GTRA or band staff member will proctor the auditions during which you will enter the room silently, play the required items, and leave silently. This process promotes fairness and rewards progress. The audition music for winds can be found at http://bands.truman.edu/current-students/ categorized by instrument. All Clarinets will audition on Bb soprano or Bass.

All auditions will be completed during the first two days of classes and will be posted outside my office by Wednesday morning as well as emailed. Regular ensemble rehearsals will begin Wednesday, August 21. If you have an unavoidable conflict with the audition, please email me (cprend@truman.edu), and arrangements for an alternate audition time will be made. *Please make every effort to attend your instrument's audition time*.
